Project Summary & Goals

The Washington County Health Center Coalition formed in the fall of 2007 with the purpose of developing a health center that would co-locate health and social services and a new health clinic– the Trinity Community Clinic–for the uninsured residents of Washington County. A graduate assistant with the Center for Community Health Development, Ashleigh Dozier, wrote and submitted a grant proposal to the Office of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) requesting funding to support the Coalition’s renovation of the old Brenham police station which would serve as the Washington County Health Center. In February 2009, the Coalition was awarded a \$235,000 grant from ORCA.

Project goals were:

- To increase access to care for the medically indigent in Washington County
- To improve efficiency in service delivery by coordinating services for the medically indigent
